2. Notes for Application

- All the required documents must be translated and notarized into either Korean or English.
- If the admitted student does not report his or her arrival at Yeungnam University before the 1st quarter of the semester, admission will be cancelled.
- The applicant must select the department and major that he/she is applying for. Any errors made by the applicant with regards to the application process is his/her responsibility. Application documents and fees will not be returned.
- If any required documents are found to be counterfeit or are not submitted, admission will be revoked.
- Admission-related matters not specified in these guidelines shall follow the rules prescribed by the Graduate School Committee.
- Applicants who submitted a Certificate of Prospective Graduation must submit a Certificate of Graduation/Diploma right after the admission decision. Otherwise admission will be canceled.

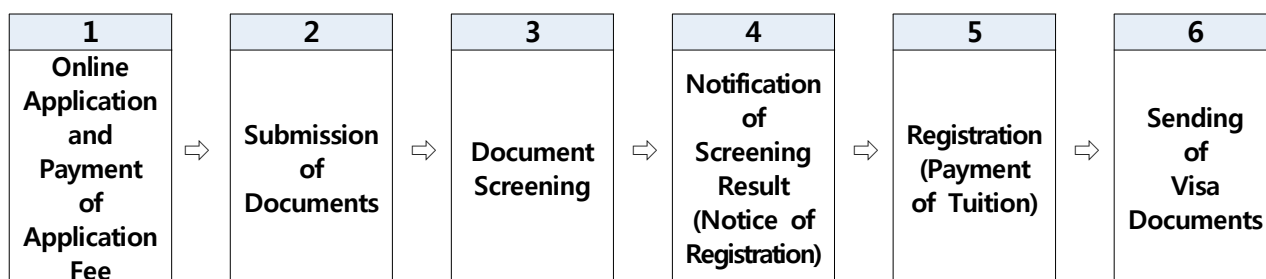
Applicants must meet one of the following requirements.

1. An applicant whose both parents hold nationalities other than Korean
2. An applicant who completed a 16-year education of elementary, middle, high school and university in countries other than Korea

- ※ Applicants can apply for any department regardless of their previous degree study field.
- ※ Applicants who hold either a Bachelor of Medicine or Bachelor of Dental Clinic degree are eligible to apply for studies in the Clinical Medicine Field of Medical Science. Applicants who do not hold a degree from the medical field are eligible to obtain a Master of Science or Ph.D. in Science degree.
- ※ International Professors for Education at the College of Basic Studies, Yeungnam University are eligible to apply for the Graduate Program at Yeungnam University.

Combined M.A./M.S. & Ph.D.	1. A Bachelor's Degree holder (or to be completed before the admission date) from an internationally recognized college or university or 2. the educational attainment equivalent to a Bachelor's Degree.

- ★ After admission, students can apply for a scholarship upgrade the following semester depending on their test scores.

※ Notes for Scholarships

- 1) The Scholarship policy may be subject to change or adjustment depending on the circumstances.

- 2) All types of scholarships are only given to applicants who apply every semester and pass the scholarship screening given by his (her) department. The criteria above shows the maximum waiver rate and scholarship type that will be decided by the respective department.
 - 3) After admission, if a student receives a grade of C or below for any one of the courses throughout a semester including Research Ethics OR an average GPA below 3.0/4.5, the student is NOT eligible to apply for a 100%, 70% or 50% tuition waiver in the following semester. Students who received a 30% tuition waiver but obtained a grade of C, F, OR GPA below 3.0/4.5 in the previous semester are not eligible to receive any scholarships for the following semester.
 - 4) All students must purchase medical insurance available in Korea according to the Korean Government Policy. [A student can purchase medical insurance in Korea after admission (by the beginning of September 2020) or submit any document of medical insurance that is accepted in Korea to the graduate school office]
 - 5) A student receiving a 100%, 70% or 50% scholarship must work as a Teaching or Research Assistant for approximately 10 hours every week.
 - 6) 'International Professors for Education' of the College of Basic Studies of Yeungnam University are eligible for the 30% scholarship according to the University policy.
 - 7) Each scholarship does not cover the admission fee.
